The land is contained within one enclosure with hedgerow and fenced boundaries. The land would lend itself to both arable and grassland farming alike with the Agricultural Land Classification detailing the Land as Grade 3 which is good to moderate quality. The land is classified as Soilscapes 8 with slightly acid loamy and clayey soils.

DIRECTIONS AND ACCESS

From Bache Train station (Chester), travel north along Mill Lane for approximately ½ a mile. At the roundabout continue straight onto Heath Rd for ½ a mile, and then take a left hand turn down Flag Lane to join the A41. Follow the A41 for just less than a mile, and the access point to the land is on the left hand side.

The property, notwithstanding any description contained in these particulars, is sold subject to any development plan, tree preservation order, town planning scheme or agreement, resolution or notice.

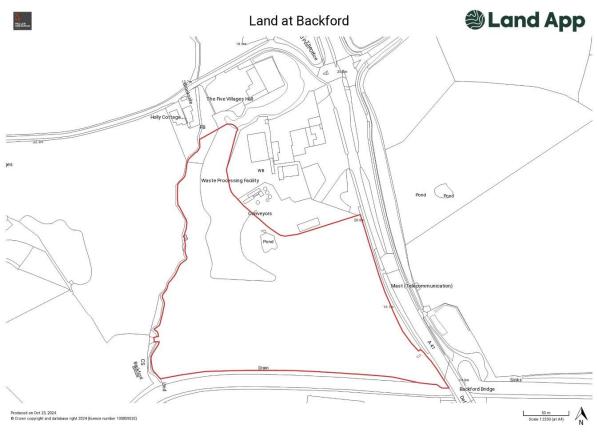
OVERAGE
